Need your provisional education?

If you are a first year licensee, you will need to satisfy the provisional education requirement. These are courses required by the Oklahoma Real Estate Commission (OREC) to fulfill your real estate license requirements.

Great News - Four of the six GRI courses are approved by OREC to satisfy your provisional requirement! That means you'll be 2/3 of the way to earning a prestigious national designation by the time you have satisfied your provisional education requirement!
